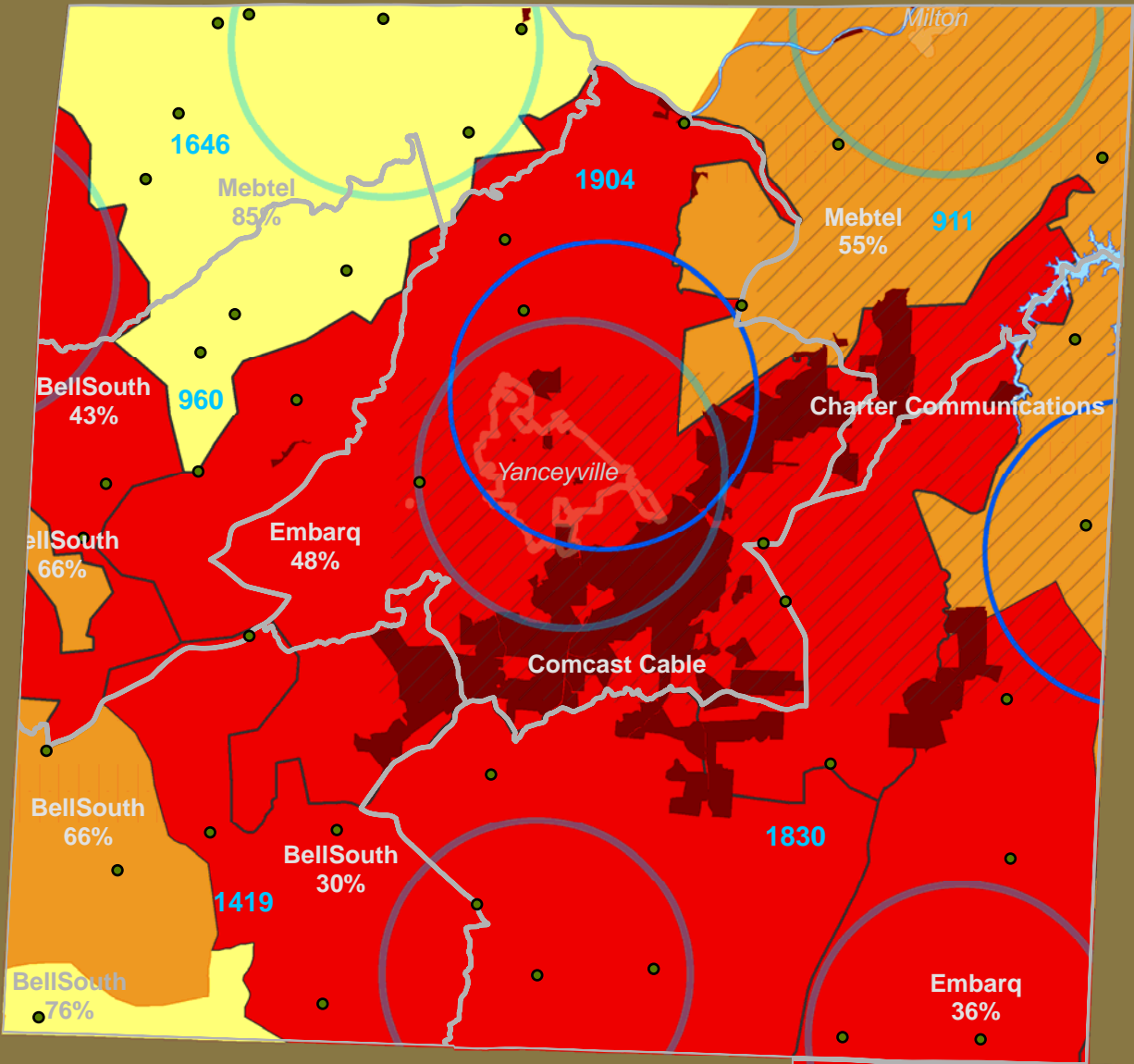


District 50: Caswell and Orange Counties
