CHAPTER 1065
SENATE BILL 198

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CAROLINA CHARTER TRICENTENARY
2 COMMISSION.

4 WHEREAS, the General Assembly in 1959 passed An Act establishing the Carolina
5 Charter Tercentenary Commission; and

6 WHEREAS, this Commission has been developing and is continuing to develop
7 plans and programs for an appropriate and suitable series of commemorations and activities
8 marking the 300th anniversary of the granting of the Carolina Charter to the eight Lords
9 Proprietors; and

10 WHEREAS, in order to perform this function on a scale and at a high quality
11 commensurate with the importance and dignity of the State of North Carolina and its citizens,
12 adequate funds will be needed: Now, therefore,

14 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

16 **Section 1.** The Carolina Charter Tercentenary Commission is hereby authorized
17 and directed to continue developing and executing its plans and programs for the Tercentenary
18 of the granting of the Carolina Charter.

19 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Carolina Charter
20 Tercentenary Commission the sum of sixty-one thousand nine hundred dollars (\$61,900.00) for
21 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1961, and ending June 30, 1962, and one hundred thirty-three
22 thousand ninety dollars (\$133,090.00) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1962, and ending
23 June 30, 1963, to be used by said Commission to continue developing and executing its plans
24 and programs for the Tercentenary of the granting of the Carolina Charter.

25 **Sec. 3.** Nothing in this Act shall be interpreted as repealing or amending Session
26 Laws of 1959, Chapter 1238, Section 4, which reads as follows: "In order to meet the expenses
27 of the aforesaid Commission in attending to their official duties, in employing necessary
28 personnel, and in meeting other necessary expenses, allotments may be made from the
29 Contingency and Emergency Fund at such times and in such amounts as may be approved by
30 the Governor and Council of State."

31 **Sec. 4.** Further to clarify and make effective Chapter 371, Session Laws of 1955, as
32 amended by Chapter 398, Session Laws of 1957, any county or municipality is hereby
33 authorized to appropriate funds other than ad valorem tax funds for any celebrations,
34 observances, publications, museum collections, or any other actions or activities that are a part
35 of, or connected with, the celebration of the Tercentenary of the granting of the Carolina
36 Charter.

37 **Sec. 5.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

38 **Sec. 6.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
