HOUSE BILL 1071

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 123 OF THE PUBLIC-LOCAL LAWS OF 1929,  
RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY AND PENSION FUND FOR THE LAW  
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF WAKE COUNTY, SO AS TO INCLUDE  
CERTAIN STATE HIGHWAY PATROLMEN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 123 of the Public-Local Laws of 1929 is hereby amended by inserting the following words immediately following the word "crime," in line 5 thereof:

"including all Highway Patrolmen assigned to patrolling the highways in Wake County and assigned to the Sergeant's patrol district in which Wake County is located,".

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 21st day of June, 1961.
