1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 122-50 RELATING TO RECORDS OF ALLEGEDLY
2 MENTALLY DISORDERED PERSONS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** Section 122-50 of the General Statutes of North Carolina is hereby
7 amended by adding at the end thereof the following: "Provided, that when a mentally
8 disordered person who is a resident of this State is committed in some county other than the
9 county of his residence, the Clerk of Superior Court in the county of such person's residence
10 shall maintain the records specified in this Section upon receipt of a certified copy of such
11 records from the Clerk of the Superior Court of the county of commitment."

12 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

13 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
