HOUSE BILL 1094

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING BOARDS OF CERTAIN STATE
2 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS TO REGISTER AND REGULATE MOTOR
3 VEHICLES MAINTAINED AND OPERATED BY STUDENTS THEREIN ON THE
4 CAMPUSES THEREOF.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

8 **Section 1.** Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by adding
9 thereto a new Article to be designated Article 20 and to be entitled "Registration and
10 Regulation of Motor Vehicles Maintained and Operated by Students on Campuses." and to read
11 as follows:

12 "ARTICLE 20.

13 "Registration and Regulation of Motor Vehicles Maintained and Operated by Students on
14 Campuses.

15 **"§ 116-186. Registration and regulation of motor vehicles maintained and operated by**
16 **students on campuses.** The Boards of Trustees of the University of North Carolina (including
17 the University at Chapel Hill, the State College of Agriculture and Engineering and the
18 Woman's College of the University of North Carolina), East Carolina College, Western
19 Carolina College, Appalachian State Teachers College, Pembroke State College, Agricultural
20 and Technical College of North Carolina, North Carolina College of Durham, Elizabeth City
21 State Teachers College, Fayetteville State Teachers College, Winston-Salem Teachers College
22 and community colleges organized under the provisions of Article 3 of Chapter 116 of the
23 General Statutes are hereby authorized to adopt reasonable rules and regulations governing the
24 registration and operation on campus of motor vehicles maintained and operated by students
25 therein on the campuses thereof and may, in connection with such registration, charge a fee
26 therefor not in excess of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) annually, which fee shall be placed in a
27 special fund at each institution to be used by appropriate resolution of the trustees to develop,
28 maintain and supervise parking areas, provided, however, no fee shall be charged on those
29 motor vehicles operated by physically handicapped students.

30 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

31 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1961.
