HOUSE BILL 1125

1 AN ACT RELATING TO THE DISPOSAL OF DEAD AND DISEASED POULTRY AT
2 COMMERCIAL POULTRY FARMS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** Every person, firm or corporation engaged in growing poultry, turkeys
7 or other domestic fowl or products thereof for commercial purpose shall provide and maintain a
8 disposal pit or incinerator of a size and design, approved by the Department of Agriculture,
9 wherein all dead diseased poultry carcasses shall be disposed of in a manner to prevent the
10 spread of disease; provided, that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to growers of poultry,
11 turkeys or other domestic fowl with flocks of two hundred (200) or less.

12 **Sec. 2.** Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Act shall,
13 upon conviction, be fined or imprisoned in the discretion of the court.

14 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

15 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective January 1, 1962.
