CHAPTER 126  
HOUSE BILL 151

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PENDER  
COUNTY TO FIX THE FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF  
SUPERIOR COURT OF SAID COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of Pender County is authorized and empowered to fix in its discretion all fees and commissions which may be charged by the clerk of Superior Court of said county. Such fees and commissions may be fixed from time to time by resolution of the board of county commissioners, and when once fixed, may be changed at any time but may not be increased or decreased more than fifty per cent (50%) during any one fiscal year.

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 28th day of March, 1961.
