HOUSE BILL 75

1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 7-70 SO AS TO FIX THE TERMS OF SUPERIOR COURT TO
2 BE HELD IN CALDWELL COUNTY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** That portion of G.S. 7-70, as the same appears in the 1959 Cumulative
7 Supplement to Volume 1B of the General Statutes, fixing the terms of Superior Court to be
8 held in Caldwell County is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 "Caldwell. The sixth Monday before the first Monday in March to continue two weeks for
10 the trial of civil cases only; the first Monday before the first Monday in March to continue two
11 weeks for the trial of criminal and civil cases; the third Monday after the first Monday in March
12 to continue two weeks for the trial of civil cases only; the eleventh Monday after the first
13 Monday in March to continue two weeks for the trial of criminal and civil cases; the second
14 Monday before the first Monday in September to continue two weeks for the trial of criminal
15 and civil cases; the second Monday after the first Monday in September to continue two weeks
16 for the trial of civil cases only; the seventh Monday after the first Monday in September to
17 continue two weeks for the trial of civil cases only; the thirteenth Monday after the first
18 Monday in September to continue two weeks for the trial of criminal and civil cases."

19 **Sec. 2.** That paragraph of G.S. 7-70 which provides for a two week civil term of
20 court in Caldwell County beginning the fifteenth Monday after the first Monday in March is
21 hereby repealed.

22 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

23 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective July 1, 1961.

24 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of March,
25 1961.
