CHAPTER 153
SENATE BILL 74

AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF
EDUCATION OF NASH COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. From and after the first day of July, 1961, the members of the Board of Education of Nash County shall be paid a total salary of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) each per annum, and the necessary funds for said salaries, in excess of the amount provided annually by the State Board of Education on the salaries of said members, shall be provided for by the Board of Commissioners of Nash County in the same manner as said board of commissioners is now required to provide funds for the maintenance of plant, fixed charges and capital outlay with respect to public schools.

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1961.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 4th day of April, 1961.
