CHAPTER 162
HOUSE BILL 230

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 535 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1955
RELATING TO THE RECORDER'S COURT OF HARNETT COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Chapter 535 of the Session Laws of 1955 is amended by adding a new Section immediately following Section 8 to be designated as "Section 8.1" and to read as follows:

"Sec. 8.1. All judgments in civil actions, excepting those for costs only, rendered by the Recorder's Court shall be duly docketed in the Office of the Clerk of the Superior Court, and execution shall issue thereon as is now provided by law for execution upon judgments of the Superior Court."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 4th day of April, 1961.
