HOUSE BILL 251

1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 143-286 OF THE NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL STATUTES
2 BY INSERTING THEREIN A NEW PARAGRAPH TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN
3 EMPLOYEES OF THE JOHN H. KERR RESERVOIR DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION
4 TO BE COMMISSIONED SPECIAL PEACE OFFICERS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

8 **Section 1.** G.S. 143-286 of the North Carolina General Statutes is hereby amended
9 by adding a new paragraph thereto to read as follows:

10 "Upon application by the John H. Kerr Reservoir Development Commission, the Governor
11 is hereby authorized and empowered to commission as special officers such of the employees
12 of the John H. Kerr Reservoir Development Commission as the commission may designate for
13 the purpose of enforcing the laws, rules and regulations, enacted or adopted for the protection,
14 preservation and government of parks, lakes, reservations and other lands or waters under the
15 control or supervision of the John H. Kerr Reservoir Development Commission. Such
16 employees shall receive no additional compensation for performing the duties of special peace
17 officers. Employees so commissioned special peace officers as herein provided shall have the
18 same powers of arrest, give bond, and be required to take an oath as provided for special police
19 officers under G.S. 113-28.2, G.S. 113-28.3 and G.S. 113-28.4 of the North Carolina General
20 Statutes."

21 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
22 hereby repealed.

23 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

24 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 13th day of April,
25 1961.
