CHAPTER 271  
HOUSE BILL 380

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE PRACTICE OF PHRENOLOGY, PALMISTRY,  
FORTUNE TELLING OR CLAIRVOYANCE IN IREDELL COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. G. S. 14-401.5, prohibiting the practice of phrenology, palmistry, fortune telling or clairvoyance, is hereby amended by inserting the following word and punctuation "Hoke," and preceding the word and punctuation "Johnston," the word and punctuation "Iredell," and preceding the word and punctuation "Sampson," the word and punctuation "Rutherford," in the last paragraph thereof.

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 25th day of April, 1961.
