CHAPTER 279  
HOUSE BILL 392

AN ACT TO AMEND GS 153-10 RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY TO INTERDICT  
CERTAIN SHOWS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. G. S. 153-10, as the same appears in the 1959 Cumulative Supplement to Volume 3C of the General Statutes, is hereby amended by inserting after the comma following the word "Madison" and before the word "Mitchell", in line 12 thereof, the word "Martin".

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 25th day of April, 1961.
