CHAPTER 283
HOUSE BILL 464

AN ACT TO AMEND GS 9-4 RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF JURORS TO BE
DRAWN IN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The paragraph of G. S. 9-4, as the same appears in Volume 1B of the General Statutes, relating to the number of jurors to be drawn in Rockingham County, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"In Rockingham County the Board of County Commissioners may cause to be drawn from the jury box, in its discretion, the following number of jurors:

"For the first week of the criminal terms of court beginning after January 1 and July 1, 45 jurors;

"For all other terms and weeks of court, 36 jurors."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 25th day of April, 1961.
