CHAPTER 30
HOUSE BILL 76

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 606 OF THE 1959 SESSION LAWS FIXING THE
TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MCDOWELL
COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 606 of the 1959 Session Laws is hereby amended by striking out the word and figure "six (6)" immediately following the word "and" and immediately preceding the word "respectively" in line 5 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "four (4)".

Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 606 of the Session Laws of 1959 is hereby rewritten to read as follows:

"At the general election of the year 1962, and biennially thereafter, there shall be elected one member of the board of county commissioners for each member whose term expires at that time."

Sec. 3. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 10th day of March, 1961.
