CHAPTER 334
HOUSE BILL 443

1 AN ACT TO EXEMPT FROM REGISTRATION THOSE SMALL FARM TRAILERS
2 KNOWN GENERALLY AS TOBACCO HANDLING TRAILERS, TOBACCO TRUCKS
3 OR TOBACCO TRAILERS WHEN USED IN CONNECTION WITH HARVESTING OR
4 CURING TOBACCO.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

8 **Section 1.** G.S. 20-51 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be
9 designated Subsection (g) and to read as follows:

10 "(g) Those small farm trailers known generally as tobacco handling trailers, tobacco
11 trucks or tobacco trailers when used by a farmer, his tenant, agent or employee, when
12 transporting or otherwise handling tobacco in connection with the pulling, tying or curing
13 thereof."

14 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

15 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
