SENATE BILL 135

1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 20-190 WITH REGARD TO THE COLOR OF MOTOR
2 VEHICLES DRIVEN BY OFFICERS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** G.S. 20-190 is hereby amended by:

7 (a) Changing the period (.) following the word "duty" at the end of the first
8 unnumbered paragraph thereof to a comma (,) and adding at the end of such first unnumbered
9 paragraph the following:

10 "provided, that not less than seventy-nine per cent (79%) of the number of motor vehicles
11 operated on the highways of the State by members of the State Highway Patrol shall be painted
12 a uniform color of black and silver."; and

13 (b) Striking out the second unnumbered paragraph thereof.

14 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

15 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
