CHAPTER 351
HOUSE BILL 479

AN ACT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE SHERIFF OF HARNETT
COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 894 of the Session Laws of 1959 is rewritten to read as follows:

"Section 1. From and after the effective date of this Act the Sheriff of Harnett County shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars (\$450.00) per month to be paid from the general fund of said county. In addition thereto, the sheriff shall receive the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per month for the use of his automobile and the operation thereof in the performance of his duties, said amount to be paid from the general fund of said county."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective as of the first day of July, 1961.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 3rd day of May, 1961.
