CHAPTER 358
SENATE BILL 225

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 167 OF THE PRIVATE LAWS OF 1915, THE
CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF FUQUAY SPRINGS, RELATING TO THE
SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF SAID TOWN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 167 of the Private Laws of 1915, as rewritten by Chapter 774, Session Laws of 1959, the same being the Charter of the Town of Fuquay Springs, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following: "The mayor shall receive a salary of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per year, and the commissioners shall each receive a salary of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per year."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 5th day of May, 1961.
