HOUSE BILL 178

1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE STATE CAPITAL PLANNING COMMISSION.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
4

5 **Section 1.** Chapter 129 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by the addition
6 thereto of a new Article, which shall be designated "Article 5. State Capital Planning
7 Commission.", and shall read as follows:

8 "Article 5.

9 "State Capital Planning Commission.

10 "**§ 129-26. Commission created.** There is hereby created 'The State Capital Planning
11 Commission', which shall consist of nine persons appointed by the Governor. At least two
12 members shall be persons who have served in the General Assembly. All members shall be
13 appointed on July 1, 1961, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, and shall serve until the
14 completion of the duties assigned to the Commission. The Governor shall appoint to fill any
15 vacancy occurring in the membership of the Commission. The Chairman of the Commission
16 shall be designated by the Governor from among the Commission membership.

17 "**§ 129-27. Powers and duties of the Commission.** The State Capital Planning Commission
18 shall have the following powers and duties:

19 "(1) To make a thorough investigation of present State laws, policies, and
20 practices with respect to the financing location, planning, and construction of
21 buildings and other capital improvements for State governmental agencies in
22 the City of Raleigh.

23 "(2) To analyze the building requirements of State governmental agencies in the
24 City of Raleigh over such period as the Commission deems advisable, and to
25 formulate and recommend to the Governor and the General Assembly a
26 long-range capital improvement policy and program to aid the Governor and
27 the General Assembly in meeting those requirements and a master plan for
28 the future development of the physical plant of State government in the City
29 of Raleigh over such period as the Commission deems advisable.

30 "(3) To call upon the Department of Administration for assistance and to employ
31 such other assistance as the Commission may find necessary in the execution
32 of its duties.

33 "**§ 129-28. Per diem and allowances.** The members of the State Capital Planning Commission
34 shall receive for their services the same per diem and allowances as are granted the members of
35 State boards and commissions generally.

36 "**§ 129-29. Expenses.** All expenses of the Commission shall be paid from the Contingency and
37 Emergency Fund, upon application in the manner prescribed in G.S. 143-12.

38 "**§ 129-30. Expiration.** The State Capital Planning Commission shall expire upon certification
39 by the Chairman of the Commission to the Governor that, in the opinion of the Commission, it
40 has performed all of the duties assigned to it by this Article, but shall in any event expire not
41 later than July 1, 1965."

42 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

43 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall take effect upon its ratification.
