CHAPTER 388
HOUSE BILL 381

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 396 OF THE PUBLIC-LOCAL AND PRIVATE
LAWS OF 1941 RELATING TO JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN HIGH POINT
TOWNSHIP IN GUILFORD COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The second paragraph of Section 1 of Chapter 396 of the Public-Local and Private Laws of 1941 is rewritten to read as follows:

"The number of Justices of the Peace for High Point Township is hereby limited to seven and there shall be no power, either by election or appointment, whereby the number of said officers shall be increased."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 9th day of May, 1961.
