CHAPTER 479
HOUSE BILL 651

AN ACT TO APPOINT A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF DAVIE
COUNTY TO REPLACE S. W. FURCHES, NOW DECEASED.

WHEREAS, in House Bill 220, which was an Act to appoint members of the boards of education of the respective counties of North Carolina and to fix their terms of office, S. W. Furches was appointed a member of the Davie County Board of Education for a term of six years; and

WHEREAS, the said S. W. Furches unfortunately died on April 22, 1961:
Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. That L. W. West be and he is hereby appointed a member of the Davie County Board of Education in lieu of S. W. Furches, now deceased, for a term of six years, from and after the first Monday in April 1961.

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 23rd day of May, 1961.
