CHAPTER 503
HOUSE BILL 732

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 57 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1959 RELATING
TO THE LETTING OF PUBLIC CONTRACTS FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION
PURPOSES IN BRUNSWICK COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The quoted portion of Section 1 of Chapter 57 of the Session Laws of 1959 is rewritten to read as follows:

"The provisions of this Article shall not apply to the County Board of Education of Brunswick County in the expenditure of public funds by said board for the construction of physical education and recreational facilities at any high school in Brunswick County when the total costs of such construction shall not exceed the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) each, if the completed projects or structures are performed by or through duly elected officers, employees or agents of the County Board of Education of said county."

Sec. 2. Chapter 532 of the Session Laws of 1959 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 25th day of May, 1961.
