CHAPTER 615
HOUSE BILL 815

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE POLICEMEN AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF GARNER TO MAKE ARRESTS AND SERVE CRIMINAL PROCESS AT ANY PLACE IN WAKE COUNTY WITHIN A RADIUS OF ONE MILE DISTANCE FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID TOWN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. All policemen, town constables, town marshals or other law enforcement officers of the Town of Garner charged with the duty of making arrests or otherwise enforcing the criminal laws are hereby authorized and empowered to make arrests and to serve any and all process at any point or place in Wake County within a distance of one mile from the corporate limits or boundaries of said Town of Garner, but not within the corporate limits of any other municipality.

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 2nd day of June, 1961.
