CHAPTER 616
HOUSE BILL 822

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 789, SESSION LAWS OF 1955, TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LONGVIEW, IN CATAWBA COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Chapter 789, Session Laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new Section following Section 3 to be designated Section 3 ½ and to read as follows:

"Sec. 3½. For each regular or special meeting of the Board of Aldermen attended, compensation to each alderman in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00) and to the Mayor in the amount of seven dollars (\$7.00), shall be paid."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after June 30, 1961.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 2nd day of June, 1961.
