CHAPTER 673  
HOUSE BILL 758

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE STYLE OF THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF  
LEAKSVILLE TO CITY OF LEAKSVILLE IN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The style of the name of the Town of Leaksville in Rockingham County as set forth in the laws enacted pertaining thereto is hereby changed and the official style of the name of said municipality shall henceforth be the "City of Leaksville".

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 6th day of June, 1961.
