CHAPTER 688
HOUSE BILL 886

AN ACT RELATING TO THE USE OF CONSTRUCTION FUNDS BY THE HYDE
COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 7 IN HYDE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. The Board of Drainage Commissioners of Hyde County Drainage District No. 7 in Hyde County is hereby authorized to use in its discretion funds now on hand in the office of the County Accountant of Hyde County belonging to the district designated as "Construction Funds" for the purpose of further improving and deepening the main drainage canal of the district and enlarging its dykes, where necessary, and for such other capital improvements as the board of drainage commissioners may consider for the benefit of the drainage canals of said district.

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 8th day of June, 1961.
