SENATE BILL 384

1 AN ACT TO AMEND G.S. 7-70 RELATING TO THE TERMS OF SUPERIOR COURT TO
2 BE HELD IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** That portion of G.S. 7-70 which sets forth the terms of Superior Court to
7 be held in Cumberland County is hereby amended by rewriting the second paragraph to read as
8 follows:

9 "In addition to the terms of court provided for above there shall be held in the County of
10 Cumberland the following terms of court: The fourth Monday before the first Monday in March
11 to continue two weeks for the trial of civil cases only; the second Monday before the first
12 Monday in March to continue one week for the trial of criminal cases only; the first Monday in
13 March to continue one week for the trial of civil cases only; the fourth Monday after the first
14 Monday in March to continue one week for the trial of criminal cases only; the eighth Monday
15 after the first Monday in March to continue one week for the trial of civil cases only; the third
16 Monday after the first Monday in September to continue two weeks for the trial of civil cases
17 only; the sixth Monday after the first Monday in September to continue one week for the trial
18 of criminal cases only; the ninth Monday after the first Monday in September to continue two
19 weeks for the trial of civil cases only. The Chief Justice shall assign a regular, special, or
20 emergency judge to hold the terms of court set forth in this paragraph."

21 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

22 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective July 1, 1961.

23 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 15th day of June,
24 1961.
