1 AN ACT TO DIVIDE NORTH CAROLINA INTO ELEVEN CONGRESSIONAL
2 DISTRICTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** For the purpose of selecting representatives to the Congress of the
7 United States, the State of North Carolina shall be divided into eleven districts as follows:

8 FIRST DISTRICT: Beaufort, Bertie, Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Gates,
9 Hertford, Hyde, Martin, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Pitt, Tyrrell and
10 Washington Counties;

11 SECOND DISTRICT: Edgecombe, Franklin, Greene, Halifax, Lenoir,
12 Northampton, Vance, Warren and Wilson Counties;

13 THIRD DISTRICT: Carteret, Craven, Duplin, Harnett, Jones, Onslow, Pamlico,
14 Pender, Sampson and Wayne Counties;

15 FOURTH DISTRICT: Chatham, Davidson, Johnston, Nash, Randolph and Wake
16 Counties;

17 FIFTH DISTRICT: Caswell, Forsyth, Granville, Person, Rockingham, Stokes, Surry
18 and Wilkes Counties;

19 SIXTH DISTRICT: Alamance, Durham, Guilford and Orange Counties;

20 SEVENTH DISTRICT: Bladen, Brunswick, Columbus, Cumberland, Hoke, New
21 Hanover, Robeson and Scotland Counties;

22 EIGHTH DISTRICT: Anson, Lee, Lincoln, Mecklenburg, Montgomery, Moore,
23 Richmond and Union Counties;

24 NINTH DISTRICT: Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Cabarrus, Caldwell, Davie,
25 Iredell, Rowan, Stanly, Watauga and Yadkin Counties;

26 TENTH DISTRICT: Avery, Burke, Catawba, Cleveland, Gaston, Mitchell and
27 Rutherford Counties;

28 ELEVENTH DISTRICT: Buncombe, Cherokee, Clay, Graham, Haywood,
29 Henderson, Jackson, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Polk, Swain,
30 Transylvania and Yancey Counties.

31 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

32 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
