CHAPTER 90
HOUSE BILL 161

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 156 OF THE PRIVATE LAWS OF 1929, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 35 OF THE PRIVATE LAWS OF 1931, RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF BOXING AND WRESTLING EXHIBITIONS IN BUNCOMBE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 156 of the Private Laws of 1929, as amended by Chapter 35 of the Private Laws of 1931, is hereby amended by striking out the words "the City of Asheville" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Buncombe County".

Sec. 2. Section 4 of Chapter 156 of the Private Laws of 1929 is hereby amended by inserting in line three the words "in Buncombe County" immediately following the word "exhibition".

Sec. 3. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 23rd day of March, 1961.
