CHAPTER 939
HOUSE BILL 1116

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 1142 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1959
RELATING TO THE FRANKLIN COUNTY PEACE OFFICERS' RELIEF
ASSOCIATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

Section 1. Section 10 of Chapter 1142 of the Session Laws of 1959 is hereby amended by striking out the period immediately following the words "group insurance" in line 5, substituting a colon in lieu thereof, and adding the following words: "Provided, however, any law enforcement officer who devotes less than fifty per cent (50%) of full time to the performance of law enforcement duties in Franklin County shall not be entitled to more than fifty per cent (50%) of the benefits herein authorized."

Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 16th day of June, 1961.
