HOUSE BILL 567

1 AN ACT TO AMEND PART 2 OF ARTICLE 3 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES
2 RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF DEPENDENT CHILDREN ELIGIBLE FOR
3 PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7 **Section 1.** Part 2, entitled "Aid to Dependent Children", of Article 3 of Chapter 108
8 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new Section immediately following
9 G.S. 108-49, to be numbered G.S. 108-50, and to read as follows:

10 "**§ 108-50.** Dependent children of unemployed parents: Cooperative arrangements with
11 employment offices: Termination of Federal aid. (a) The term 'dependent child' as used in this
12 Section shall, in addition to the definition set forth in G.S. 108-49, include any needy child
13 under the age of 18 years who has been deprived of parental support or care by reason of the
14 unemployment of a parent and who is living with any of the relatives specified in G.S. 108-49
15 in a place of residence maintained by one or more of such relatives as his or their home.

16 "(b) An unemployed parent, within the meaning of this Section, is defined as an
17 employable person who is residing in North Carolina; who is registered with the Employment
18 Security Commission for work; who has no employment; who has no Social Security benefits;
19 and who has received unemployment compensation benefits but has exhausted the full benefits
20 to which such parent was entitled.

21 "(c) The State Board of Public Welfare shall by rule and regulation provide for the
22 entering into of cooperative agreements with the various public employment offices in the
23 State, including appropriate provisions for registration and periodic re-registration of the
24 unemployed parent of any such child, and for maximum utilization of the job placement
25 services and other services and facilities of such employment offices.

26 "(d) If at the end of the period set forth in the 1961 amendment to the Federal Social
27 Security Act by the 87th Congress (June 30, 1962), or at any future date, there is a termination
28 of Federal aid for the purposes set forth in this Section, this Section shall be ipso facto repealed
29 and declared null and void in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 108-76."

30 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Public Welfare for the
31 fiscal year 1961-62 the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), and for the fiscal year
32 1962-63, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), for and only for the purposes of this
33 Act. State expenditures for the purposes of this Act shall not exceed the sums hereinabove
34 appropriated, and no additional funds shall be transferred or allocated for the purposes of this
35 Section.

36 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
37 hereby repealed.

38 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

39 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 17th day of June,
40 1961.
