HOUSE BILL 1165

1 AN ACT TO EXEMPT NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION ACTIVITY BUS DRIVERS FROM
2 THE CHAUFFEURS LICENSE REQUIREMENT AND TO RESTRICT THE SPEED OF
3 SUCH BUSES TO 45 MPH WHEN LOADED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
6

7 **Section 1.** Paragraph 2 of G.S. 20-6 as the same appears in the 1965 Replacement
8 Volume 1C of the North Carolina General Statutes is hereby amended on line 7 of the second
9 paragraph by deleting all of paragraph 2 following the word "capacity" and inserting in lieu
10 thereof the following words: "except the driver of a church bus, farm bus, school bus or an
11 activity bus for a non-profit organization when such bus is being operated for a non-profit
12 purpose, who holds a valid operator's license." Those under twenty (20) years of age must be
13 certified and licensed to operate a North Carolina school bus.

14 **Sec. 2.** Article 7 of Chapter 20, North Carolina General Statutes, as the same
15 appears in the 1965 Replacement Volume 1C is hereby amended by adding a new Section
16 thereto to be numbered 20-218.2 and to read as follows:

17 "**G.S. 20-218.2.** It shall be unlawful for any person to operate an activity bus for a non-profit
18 organization for a non-profit purpose which is being used for transportation of persons in
19 connection with non-profit activities in excess of 45 miles per hour.

20 Any person violating paragraph 1 of this Section shall, upon conviction, be fined not more
21 than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days."

22 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

23 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.

24 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 23rd day of June,
25 1969.
