CHAPTER 1019  
HOUSE BILL 985

1 AN ACT TO REVOKE ALL SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS OF FUNDS FOR THE  
2 ASSISTANCE OF STUDENTS WHO ARE CONVICTED, ENTER A PLEA OF GUILTY  
3 OR NOLO CONTENDERE TO A CHARGE OF RIOT, INCITING A RIOT, TRESPASS  
4 OR THE SEIZURE OF THE BUILDINGS OR FACILITIES ON THE CAMPUSES OF  
5 STATE-SUPPORTED COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

9       **Section 1.** Any student regularly registered and enrolled as an undergraduate,  
10 graduate, or professional student in a State-supported college, university or community college  
11 who shall be convicted, enter a plea of guilty or nolo contendere upon an indictment or charge  
12 for engaging in a riot, inciting a riot, unlawful demonstration or assembly, seizing or occupying  
13 a building or facility, sitting down in buildings they have seized, or lying down in entrances to  
14 buildings or any facilities, or on the campus of any college, university, or community college,  
15 or any student, whether an undergraduate, graduate or professional student who shall forfeit an  
16 appearance bond on an indictment or charge of any of the above named offenses, shall have  
17 revoked and withdrawn from his benefit all state supported scholarships or any State funds  
18 granted to him for educational assistance. It shall be the duty of all persons or officials having  
19 charge of and authority over the granting of State supported scholarships or any other form of  
20 financial assistance to immediately revoke and withdraw same in the event and upon the  
21 happening of any of the conditions or matters above enumerated; provided, however, that in  
22 subsequent academic terms any such student shall be eligible to be considered for and to be  
23 granted financial assistance from State funds.

24       **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are  
25 hereby repealed.

26       **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.

27       In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 23rd day of June,  
28 1969.
