CHAPTER 1030 **HOUSE BILL 1008**

1	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PERMANENT HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES FOR
2	STATE RESIDENTS OVER 65 YEARS OF AGE.

4	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
5	
6	Section 1. G.S. 113-95 is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph at the end
7	thereof to read as follows:
8	"Any resident of this State who has attained the age of sixty-five years may, upon making
9	application, including satisfactory proof of age, to the License Section of the Wildlife
10	Resources Commission at its headquarters in Raleigh, and upon payment of a fee of ten dollars
11	(\$10.00), receive from the Commission a nontransferable combination hunting and fishing
12	license which shall be valid for the life of such person. Such license shall not relieve the holder
13	thereof from the purchase of any additional license or permit which may be required for
14	hunting big game, fishing for mountain trout, hunting and fishing on public Wildlife
15	Management areas, or using special devices for fishing inland waters. Provided, however, that
16	any person 70 years of age or older shall be permitted to hunt and fish free of any charge upon
17	satisfactory proof of age."
18	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
19	Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective on August 1, 1969.
20	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 25th day of June,
21	1969.
