## CHAPTER 1053 HOUSE BILL 1340

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PER DIEM AND MILEAGE ALLOWANCE OF MEMBERS THE COLUMBUS COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND APPOINTING A NEW MEMBER TO FILL A VACANCY ON THE BOARD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

- **Section 1.** The per diem allowance of members of the Board of Education of Columbus County shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and travel allowance shall be ten cents  $(10\phi)$  per mile.
- **Sec. 2.** John Frank Carter is hereby appointed to the Board of Education of Columbus County to fill the unexpired term created by the resignation of Guy Freeman.
- **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
  - **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 26th day of June, 1969.
