## CHAPTER 1100 HOUSE BILL 34

1	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION IN THE TOWN
2	OF MURFREESBORO.
3	
4	WHEREAS, the General Assembly of 1967 has enacted a bill establishing the
5	Historic Murfreesboro Commission; and
6	WHEREAS, in order to preserve adequately the heritage of this historic community,
7	the aforesaid Historic Murfreesboro Commission will need an appropriation from the State of
8	North Carolina; and
9	WHEREAS, there now exist within the aforesaid Town of Murfreesboro many
10	buildings, dating back to an earlier, bygone period, that are now in need of restoration and
11	preservation; and
12	WHEREAS, many individual citizens and groups of citizens of this historic
13	community have donated generously of their own money, real property, personal property, and
14	various historic relics for the purpose of historic preservation in the town;
15	NOW, THEREFORE,
16	
17	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

19	<b>Section 1.</b> There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Archives and History
20	the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) for the purchase, restoration, repair, and
21	preservation of historic buildings and sites in the Town of Murfreesboro, upon the condition
22	that nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) be raised in non-state matching funds by Historic
23	Murfreesboro Commission.
24	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
25	<b>Sec. 3.</b> This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
26	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June,
27	1969.
