1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE CERTAIN FUNDS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH
2 CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL SCHOOL OF MEDICINE TO PROVIDE SPECIAL
3 TEACHER PROGRAM FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS, TO IMPROVE COMMUNITY
4 MEDICAL CARE, AND TO IMPROVE EDUCATION OF PERSONAL AND FAMILY
5 PHYSICIANS.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

9 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the State to the
10 University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Divison of Health Affairs, in addition to all other
11 funds appropriated to the University at the 1969 Session of the General Assembly, for the
12 purposes set out below the amounts set out below for each indicated year of the ensuing
13 biennium, it being the purpose and intent of this Act to appropriate for the purposes set out
14 below such sums as may be necessary to fulfill the "B" Budget requests with respect thereto:
