HOUSE BILL 307

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$127,554.00 TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA  
2 TO ESTABLISH A PROFESSOR OF FAMILY MEDICINE AT THE SCHOOL OF  
3 MEDICINE.

5 WHEREAS, a committee of the Legislative Research Commission of 1967-69  
6 found that a Professor of Family Medicine should be established at the School of Medicine at  
7 the University of North Carolina for the recruitment and training of family physicians and for  
8 the development of affiliated model practice units in North Carolina communities, as proposed  
9 by representatives of the School, and such proposal is not included in the University "B"  
10 Budget requests;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

12 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated to the University of North Carolina for the  
13 establishment of a Department of Family Medicine at the School of Medicine, co-equal with  
14 other departments in the School of Medicine, the amount of one hundred twenty-seven  
15 thousand, five hundred fifty-four dollars (\$127,554) for the biennium 1969-71.

16 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

17 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective on July 1, 1969.

18 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June,  
19 1969.
