CHAPTER 1110  
HOUSE BILL 349

1 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE REPAIR AND RESTORATION OF  
2 HISTORIC HOPE.

3  
4 WHEREAS, with funds raised from private sources and supplemented by  
5 appropriations of the General Assembly, Historic Hope, the home of Governor David Stone  
6 (1808-1810), in Bertie County has been purchased and is now being restored as an historic  
7 shrine; and

8 WHEREAS, the Historic Hope Foundation, in cooperation with the State  
9 Department of Archives and History, has planned and outlined a two-year restoration program  
10 estimated to cost seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00); and

11 WHEREAS, the Historic Hope Foundation has developed plans for the operation  
12 and maintenance of this historic house without additional State funds once its repair and  
13 restoration have been completed;

14 NOW, THEREFORE,

16 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

18 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Archives and  
19 History the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) to complete the repair and  
20 restoration of Historic Hope, including the construction of a caretaker's house, landscaping and  
21 ground improvements, and other necessary repairs and construction.

22 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

23 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
