CHAPTER 1111
HOUSE BILL 379

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA CENTER FOR ALCOHOLIC
2 STUDIES.

4 WHEREAS, within the State of North Carolina there exists a need for the study of
5 the total effect of beverage alcohol upon society; and

6 WHEREAS, there is not presently available in the southeastern region of the United
7 States any facility or center which is engaged in a comprehensive study of the total problems
8 concerning beverage alcohol; and

9 WHEREAS, a complete study of the problems relating to alcoholic beverage should
10 be undertaken in North Carolina, using the combined resources of persons concerned with
11 social, ethical, medical and safety viewpoints; and

12 WHEREAS, the University of North Carolina has the capability of undertaking this
13 study through the School of Medicine, Institute of Government, School of Social Work,
14 Department of Mental Health, Highway Safety Center, and other departments in conjunction
15 with state agencies consisting of the State Board of Alcoholic Control, State Department of
16 Mental Health, State Department of Public Health, State Department of Public Instruction,
17 Office of Attorney General, Department of Correction, and other related agencies and
18 departments; and

19 WHEREAS, a coordinator and a small staff is needed to direct a study of the total
20 problems of alcohol, alcoholism and alcoholic offenses; and

21 WHEREAS, there is needed an appropriation for this purpose;
22 NOW, THEREFORE,

24 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

26 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the State to the
27 University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) for
28 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970, and the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) for the
29 fiscal year ending June 30, 1971, for the purpose of establishing and operating the North
30 Carolina Center for Alcoholic Studies.

31 **Sec. 2.** All expenditures from the funds appropriated by this Act shall be made in
32 accordance with the provisions of the Executive Budget Act.

33 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
34 hereby repealed.

35 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective on July 1, 1969.

36 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June,
37 1969.
