1 AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF COLORING IN BREAD AND BUNS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
4

5 **Section 1.** Article 22 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
6 a new section immediately after G.S. 106-225.2 to be designated as G.S. 106-225.3 and reading
7 as follows:

8 "**Sec. 106-225.3.** No loaves of bread, rolls, or buns shall be sold or offered for sale for human
9 food which are artificially colored by natural or synthetic dyes, pigments, or other means."

10 **Sec. 2.** Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate this Act shall be guilty of
11 a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished as provided in G.S. 106-230.

12 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

13 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective ten days after ratification.

15 1969.
