CHAPTER 1135 HOUSE BILL 157

1	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RESTORATION AND MAINTENANCE
2	OF THE BOGGAN-HAMMOND HOUSE IN ANSON COUNTY.
3	
4	WHEREAS, the Boggan-Hammond House in Anson County is in great need of
5	renovation; and
6	WHEREAS, the Boggan-Hammond House was originally constructed in two wings,
7	the older wing was constructed in 1783 and the later wing was constructed in 1820; and
8	WHEREAS, upon completion, and being opened to the public, the 1783 wing will
9	be devoted to a museum of artifacts of Anson County and the 1820 wing will be restored and
10	furnished as a residence of that period; and
11	WHEREAS, it is of great importance to the people of this State and to Anson
12	County to preserve our historic buildings; and
13	WHEREAS, State appropriations will be supplemented from non-state sources;
14	NOW, THEREFORE,
15	
16	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

18	Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations made by the General Assembly of
19	1969, and on condition that the Boggan-Hammond House in Anson County be approved as a
20	Historic Site by the Historic Sites Advisory Committee, there is hereby appropriated to the
21	Anson County Historical Society, Inc., of Wadesboro, North Carolina, the sum of Twenty
22	Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), to be expended by said Society for the preservation,
23	restoration, and maintenance of properties in connection with and surrounding the
24	Boggan-Hammond House in Anson County.
25	Sec. 2. The appropriations made in Section 1 of this Act shall be used and expended
26	under the supervision of the State Department of Archives and History and in accordance with
27	the provisions of Chapter 210 of the Session Laws of 1963 (Article 1, Chapter 121 of the North
28	Carolina General Statutes). In the event that the said Boggan-Hammond House in Anson
29	County is not approved as a Historic Site by the Historic Sites Advisory Committee, the funds
30	herein appropriated shall revert to the General Fund.
31	Sec. 3. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
32	Sec. 4. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
