HOUSE BILL 621

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HISTORICAL PRESERVATION, RESEARCH,
2 AND RESTORATION IN CARTERET COUNTY.

4 WHEREAS, the County of Carteret is rich in history, containing the old seaport and
5 early whaling and fishing village of Beaufort, Fort Macon which played an important part in
6 the War Between the States, and many other significant historic sites, and

7 WHEREAS, the Beaufort Historical Association, with the aid and assistance of the
8 Richardson Foundation, has raised and expended thousands of dollars on historical research,
9 restoration, and preservation in the Town of Beaufort, and

10 WHEREAS, additional research and restoration needs to be done in the Town of
11 Beaufort, on Fort Macon, and on other historic sites in Carteret County, and

12 WHEREAS, the historic cemetery in the Town of Beaufort, dating back to the early
13 eighteenth century, has been ravaged by time and damaged by vandals and is badly in need of
14 repair and restoration;

15 NOW, THEREFORE,

17 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

19 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Archives and
20 History, for historical and archaeological research and restoration in and for the historic County
21 of Carteret:

29 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

30 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect upon its ratification.
