CHAPTER 1154 HOUSE BILL 801

1	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HISTORIC FORT DOBBS IN IREDELL
2	COUNTY.
3	
4	WHEREAS, Fort Dobbs, in what is now Iredell County, was constructed about the
5	beginning of the French and Indian War, 1754-1763, to protect the North Carolina frontier
6	against the French and Indians, and was named for the governor at that time, Arthur Dobbs; and
7	WHEREAS, by means of historical and archaelogical research the exact site of Fort
8	Dobbs has been determined; and
9	WHEREAS, it seems appropriate for this site to be further developed as a
10	significant site in North Carolina history;
11	NOW, THEREFORE,
12	
13	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
14	
15	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the State
16	Department of Archives and History, for land purchase, development, and research at Fort
17	Dobbs, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), provided an equal amount shall have
18	been raised from non-state sources.
19	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
20	Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 1969.
21	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June,
22	1969.
