4	ENGINEER.

6	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

8	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department
9	of Conservation and Development, in addition to all other appropriations, for the use of the
10	Division of Mineral Resources to implement the Mining Registration Act of 1969 and to create
11	the position of State Mining Engineer as provided in said Act the sum of twenty thousand, one
12	hundred and seventy-four dollars (\$20,174.00) for the fiscal year 1969-1970 and the sum of
13	twenty thousand, six hundred and fifty-six dollars (\$20,656.00) for the fiscal year 1970-1971.
14	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
15	Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1969.
16	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June,
17	1969.
