CHAPTER 1193 **HOUSE BILL 1349**

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE VISITOR CENTER-MUSEUM AT

2	ALAMANCE BATTLEGROUND STATE HISTORIC SITE.
3	
4	WHEREAS, on May 16, 1771, a body of some 2,000 Piedmont farmers and
5	tradesmen, calling themselves The Regulators, protesting corrupt government in the royal
6	colony of North Carolina, met and were defeated by the forces of Royal Governor William
7	Tryon in the Battle of Alamance, and
8	WHEREAS, these North Carolinians continue to live in the memory of our people
9	as examples of their dedication to the principles of liberty and self-government, and
10	WHEREAS, the Visitor Center-Museum at Alamance Battleground State Historic
11	Site is in great need of renovation and enlargement, and
12	WHEREAS, it will be appropriate on May 16, 1971, for the State of North Carolina
13	officially to commemorate the two-hundredth anniversary of this significant historical event
14	with the dedication of a memorial building worthy of the importance of the battle;
15	NOW, THEREFORE,
16	
17	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
18	
19	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Archives and
20	History, for the purpose of renovating and enlarging the Visitor Center-Museum at Alamance
21	Battleground State Historic Site, and of installing exhibits therein, the sum of fifty thousand
22	dollars (\$50,000.00).
23	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
24	Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 1969.
25	In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 1st day of July, 1969.
