1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$100,000 TO THE NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL FOR THE
2 DEAF AT MORGANTON TO CONSTRUCT A CHAPEL, PROVIDED MATCHING
3 FUNDS ARE MADE AVAILABLE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

7 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the State to the
8 North Carolina School for the Deaf at Morganton the sum of fifty thousand dollars
9 (\$50,000.00) to be used to construct, equip and furnish a chapel at the School, provided a like
10 or greater sum is made available in matching funds in currency for such purposes from sources
11 other than State appropriations. If matching funds have not become available by June 30, 1971,
12 this appropriation shall revert to the General Fund.

13 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

14 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective July 1, 1969.
