4	The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:
5	
6	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the State to the
7	North Carolina Zoological Authority the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars
8	(\$250,000.00) for the biennium (1969-71), to be used by said Authority for the purpose of
9	aiding said Authority in the establishment of a Zoological Garden in North Carolina, subject to
10	the following conditions:
11	(a) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) of said funds shall be transferred to said
12	Authority within ninety (90) days after said Authority is organized to enable the Board of
13	Directors to use said funds, in combination with other available funds, to begin the selection of
14	a site and the basic plan for said Zoological Garden.
15	(b) The balance of said appropriation shall be transferred upon the approval of the
16	Governor and the Advisory Budget Commission, either as one sum or several sums, upon the
17	condition that a reasonable plan is presented to said Governor and the Advisory Budget
18	Commission, which will indicate public support of a Zoological Garden and the availability of
19	a substantial amount of non-state funds for that purpose.
20	(c) It is a condition of this appropriation that the North Carolina Zoological
21	Authority will not seek additional appropriations from the General Fund during future sessions
22	of the General Assembly.
23	Sec. 2. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
24	Sec. 3. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1969.
