HOUSE BILL 560

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE BELHAVEN MEMORIAL MUSEUM.

3 WHEREAS, the Belhaven Memorial Museum has been incorporated as a nonprofit
4 educational institution for the purpose of preserving and interpreting a comprehensive
5 collection of artifacts donated by the estate of the late Eva Blount Way; and

6 WHEREAS, it is proposed to preserve this collection of artifacts in order to
7 establish data and focus attention on the historical background of the Matchapungo Basin Area;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the City of Belhaven now provides a marina and serves as a
10 recreational area for thousands of visitors who arrive annually via the Inland Waterway and
11 other routes;

12 NOW, THEREFORE,

14 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

16 **Section 1.** The sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) per year for
17 the biennium is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Archives and History for
18 cataloging, filing and planning for the Belhaven Memorial Museum.

19 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

20 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall become effective on July 1, 1969.

21 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 2nd day of July,
22 1969.
